

2015 ABT County Final South Wales 2000 October 18<sup>th</sup> 2015

The last Inter County final took place at Mike Amodeo's South Wales 2000 ground with stunning views from Mynydd Islwyn if the dull grey mist cleared, for the 54 competitors from Dyfed, Powys, Gwent and Mid Glamorgan to enjoy. With county squads making their way to the layouts if the background was difficult at least the other element that shooters hate, wind was absent.

Mid Glamorgan and Gwent had teams in the Ladies, Veteran and Super Veteran classes Dyfed had Veteran and Super veteran teams. Junior and Colts were once again thin on the ground.

Powys captain Alan Williams was the first with a 25 on the scoreboard, with Dyfed's Orwel Davies one target behind.

At the halfway stage, with the sun making a welcome appearance, Gwent's Paul Owen on 47 and Dyfed's Gareth Wrentmore one target behind were leading the senior class.

In the veteran category Gwent's Richard Hillier and Ed Donovan with Powys veterans Dave Rickets and Tim Howells were tied on 81 for team honours.

Mid Glamorgan's ladies Helen McCarney and Amanda Gallagher were locked in a private duel at the head of the their class on equal 39's.

Senior scores were tied at the three quarter stage between Paul and Gareth now on 69's. The Powys Vet's had opened a 4 target lead over Gwent .

With the day's competition drawing to a close, with hardly a broken clay to mar the day. The senior event could not have been closer, with Paul Owen's 92 taking the high gun trophy back to Gwent with only a single target more than Dyfed's Gareth Wrentmore .Powys' Tim Howells was the victorious veteran on 84. Mid Glamorgan's captain Martin Tozer's 89 saw him add the Captains trophy to his collection. Junior trophy recipient was Morgan Havard of Powys from Mid Glamorgan's Lewis Owen. Thanks to the tireless efforts of Gwent's county coordinator Angie Oliver the individual and team scores were presented soon after the last shot was fired .

The winning team by some margin making up for their disappointment of last year was Mid Glamorgan from Gwent.
