6. Business matters

5099 – Team Selections:

OT - 6 qualifiers with 3 to count. All at Griffin Lloyd as this was the only ground that applied. Points off high gun system – seniors, veterans and super veterans 20, ladies and juniors 25.

OSK - 7 qualifiers with 4 to count. Grounds – Fauxdegla, Griffin Lloyd and Crynant.

MQS – 60 for Seniors, Ladies, Veterans and Super veterans. 50 for juniors. This MQS must but obtained at a minimum of 2 shoots.

ABT - 8 qualifiers with 3 to count. Grounds – Fauxdegla and Crynant. Must include a score from each ground in final points.

Points off high gun system – seniors, veterans and super veterans 20, ladies and juniors 25.

NSK – 8 qualifiers with 4 to count. Grounds – Fauxdegla and Crynant. Must include a score from each ground in final points. Must attend 2 shoots at each ground.

MQS – 90 for Seniors, Veterans and Super veterans. 85 for Ladies and juniors.

ESP – 7 qualifiers with 4 to count. Grounds – Fauxdegla, Crynant, Hart Events, Barbury, Dovey Valley, Strata Florida.

Points off high gun system – seniors 12, veterans and super veterans 15, Ladies and juniors 25.

FSP – SH to arrange now ESP is in place.

As there are no DTL representatives present, LL to contact them for the information.

SH and LL to action

5100 – Rule book.

- Date of invoicing grounds for fees to be amended to 1st February.
- Grounds will be fined £100 should they cancel an event due to low numbers.
- Wording to be added: ‘points system’ as well as MQS as most disciplines have

changed

- Shooters must make discipline representatives aware of their preferred category by the end of the last qualifier. This does not exclude them from other eligible categories.
- An additional method of determining a team place as a result of a tie: highest average, then highest score.
- When a shooter is offered a team place, they must confirm their acceptance to the Team Manager / Discipline Representative within three days of their team place being offered.
- Shooters representing GB must also follow the above Welsh team selection process. The only exception that may be considered would be if there is space in the team (not displacing a qualified shooter.) Every effort should still be made to attend WCTSA events and would be appreciated by the board. GB Shooters gaining a team place in the above manner will not qualify for Welsh Trophies but their score will be eligible to contribute to the team total.
